From SFO, take US-101 N, take I-380 W, take I-280 N, take CA-1 N towards 19th Avenue/ Golden Gate Bridge, merge onto US-101 N and go over the Golden Gate Bridge. Then, follow the directions below "Traveling north on US-101."

Traveling north on US-101, take the Ignacio Blvd./Bel Marin Keys Blvd. Exit. Turn left on Nave Drive. Turn left on Ignacio Blvd., travel over the freeway. Turn Right onto Enfrente Road, and follow Enfrente to the left and to the right as it jogs. Turn right onto Entrada Drive and follow it as it turns to the left and dead-ends at *Inn Marin*.

From Vallejo, take CA-37 W, merge to US-101 S. Then follow the directions below "Traveling south on US-101."

Traveling south on US-101, take the Enfrente Rd. exit, turning right on Enfrente Road, right onto Entrada Drive, and follow it as it turns to the left and dead-ends at *Inn Marin*.




