- NO CONDITIONAL, INCOMPLETE, TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE, or FAX, OR THOSE WITHOUT SIGNATURES AND/OR FEES entries will be accepted. This Club and/or its Event Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the dog. This Club and its Event Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or agent entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete. No refund will be given for duplicate entries.
- RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute valid entries. The Event Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN in the event a dog is absent, sick. lame, "in season," excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

- No dogs are allowed in the show area except those regularly entered in the show. There will be NO SPACE for unentered dogs at this show.

All trophies must be claimed on the day of the show--none will be mailed.

Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs, which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Event Secretary one-half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show (*AKC Rules*, Chapter 14, Section 6)

Effective 11/1/87, No Defeated Dogs will be eligible to compete in Best of Breed Competition. Effective January 1, 1978, Castrated Dogs and Spayed Bitches are allowed to be shown in the

Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes.

As per Chapter 8, Section 7, Castrated Dogs and Spayed Bitches are allowed to be entered in the Veterans Classes at shows provided that there is no competition beyond Best of Breed. Effective January 1, 1985, foreign dogs are eligible for entry in Puppy and Open Classes.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism. The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries


Veteran Dog Class – For dogs 9 (nine) years of age and over. An entry fee of \$25 will be charged if entered in a regular class, or \$30 if not entered in a regular class. The winner of the class is eligible to compete for Best of Breed. Neutered dogs are allowed to compete in Veterans Class at independent specialties.

Veteran Bitch Class – For bitches 9 (nine) years of age and over. An entry fee of \$25 will be charged if entered in a regular class, or \$30 if not entered in a regular class. The winner of the class is eligible to compete for Best of Breed. Spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veterans Class at independent specialties.

Sled Dog Class –

- 1. Entry must be an American Kennel Club- or Canadian Kennel Club-registered Siberian Husky (eligible under Chapter 15, Section 1, of the AKC Rules Regarding Registration and Dog Shows.)
- 2. There will be a class for dogs and a class for bitches. At the discretion of Show Chair additional classes may be offered based on the requirements of the Sled Dog Degree Program.
- 3. If entered in a class for which a full entry fee was paid, no additional entry fee will be required to also exhibit in the sled dog class. If not, the entry fee to exhibit solely in Sled Dog will be a regular entry fee.
- 4. To qualify for entry in the sled dog class, the dog must have completed <u>one</u> of the following requirements:
 - a) During the previous racing season, the applicant must complete ten (10) heats on snow with a minimum of four (4) miles per heat or the total miles per season not being less than 48 miles. Of the 48 miles up to 12 miles (25%) can come from Dryland Rig Races but the applicant must complete at least two (2) heats with a minimum of three (3) miles per heat. Dryland races must be on rigs. <u>Rigs used must meet the definition of rig as defined by ISDRA under Dryland Races Rules</u> All races both snow and dry land must be under the direction of a Recognized Race Giving Organization with rules and recorded results. A race season is from April 1 through March 31 of the following year.
 - b) Entries that complete five (5) years in competition where the above rules are met shall be automatically qualified to compete in the Sled dog Class. A certificate of proof may be issued by the Chair of the Working Committee if the five years of "proof of competition" are sent in.
 - c) Entries that have been awarded an SHCA Sled Dog Certificate, either SD, SDX, or SDO, and are additionally eligible for entry in a conformation class at an AKC event, are eligible to compete in the Sled Dog Class.
- 5. Spayed and Neutered dogs are not exhibited in the Sled Dog Class as required by the SHCA Standing Rules.

A list of races in which the dog competed, or a copy of the five-year certificate, or a copy of the Sled Dog Degree Certificate must be sent to the Event Secretary when entries are made. Proof of qualification must be made available at ringside with one of these shown if challenged.

Best in Bred-By-Exhibitor Classes

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLER SERIES: (Remember to check the box near the bottom of the entry form) The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. For a detailed description of the National Owner-Handled Series, please visit the AKC website NOHS pages at: https://www.akc.org/sports/conformation/national-owner-handled-series/

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

**A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

OFFERED AT SATURDAY SPECIALTY ONLY: Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

- Stud Dog Class for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with his Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Entry fee of \$25 total for Stud Dog and two Get if all are entered in another class. An entry fee of \$25 will be charged for each one not individually entered in one of the Regular Classes, Best of Breed, or some Non-Regular or Additional Class other than Stud Dog Class.
- **Brood Bitch Class** for Brood Bitches & two of their Produce. Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with her Produce. Produce only to be judged, based on the merits of the Produce. Entry fee of \$25 total for Brood Bitch and two Produce if all are entered in another class. An entry fee of \$30 will be charged for each one not individually entered in one of the Regular Classes, Best of Breed, or some Non-Regular or Additional Class other than Brood Bitch Class.
- Brace Class (Two dogs with at least one common owner) A fee of \$25 is charged for a Brace as a Unit. The dogs comprising the Brace must be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes–"Brace Class." If more than one brace is entered by identical owner, dogs in each Brace must be designated "Brace #1," "Brace #2," etc.
- Team Class (Four dogs with at least one common owner) A fee of \$25 is charged for a Team as a Unit. The dogs comprising the Team must be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Team is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Team Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Team must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes-"Team Class." If more than one Team is entered by identical owner, the dogs in each Team must be designated-"Team #1," "Team #2," etc.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace, and Team Classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

DO YOU WANT TO GO TO AN ALL-BREED SHOW ON SUNDAY?

If you want to attend another show, on Sunday following the NCSHC's Specialties, the Chief Solano Kennel Club, Inc., is holding an all-breed show on 4/27/25 at the Yolo County Fairgrounds in Woodland, CA, 46 miles east on Highway 80. Breed and BIS judge is Jan Paulk, Group judge is Susan Norris-Jones. MB-F is the Superintendent, and the show closes on 4/9/2025.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

OFFERED AT SATURDAY SPECIALTY ONLY: JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES

- **Novice Junior Class** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.
- **Novice Intermediate Class** For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.
- **Novice Senior Class** For boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.
- **Open Junior Class** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.
- **Open Intermediate Class** For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.
- **Open Senior Class** For boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.
- Master Class For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won ten First Places with competition present, in an Open class at a licensed or member show. The calendar for this class will be November 1 October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry with charge, the day of the show if the entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time of that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.
- BEST JUNIOR HANDLER Winners from each class will compete for Best Junior Handler.

Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the breed or obedience classes at the show or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made at least one half hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or Obedience Trials. Bitches in Season are NOT ELIGIBLE. At a Specialty Show, each dog must be of the breed for which the show is held. Junior Handlers must include your Junior ID.

OFFERED AT SATURDAY SPECIALTY ONLY: PUPPY/JUNIOR SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Siberian Huskies that on the day of the show will be six (6) months & under eighteen (18) months of age, and that are not Champions of Record. Any dog entered in the Puppy Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Class, at the regular entry fee, and on the regular entry form, Puppy Sweepstakes class is shown as "Additional Entry."

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, particolor), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- 5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility. Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
